

Spanish IV – Presentational Speaking Scoring Guidelines

Task Completion and Development

- 9.5 – 10 Fully completes the task, thoroughly covers the topic, many info sources are well integrated into the presentation.
- 8.5 – 9 Appropriately completes the task, covers the topic well, multiple info sources are integrated into the presentation.
- 7.5 – 8 Completes the task, relevantly covers the topic, some info sources are integrated into the presentation.
- 6.5 – 7 Partially completes the task, coverage of the topic is somewhat irrelevant, only one or two info sources used.
- 6 Does not complete the task, coverage is somewhat irrelevant, information does not appear to be from a reliable source.

Language/Grammar Usage

- 19-20 Use and control of a variety of structures; occasional errors may occur, but there is no pattern to the type of error committed.
- 17-18 Use of complex structures; although a few errors may occur in these structures, there is generally good to very good control of elementary structures.
- 15-16 Control of simple structures with few errors; may use complex structures with little or no control.
- 13-14 Limited control of simple structures, with errors throughout.
- 12 Numerous grammatical errors occur making communication difficult.

Vocabulary Usage

- 9.5-10 Rich, precise and accurate vocabulary used
- 8.5-9 Considerable variety of vocabulary used with few mistakes.
- 7.5-8 Appropriate vocabulary, but may have occasional English language interference.
- 6.5-7 Limited vocabulary; frequent English language interference.
- 6 Insufficient vocabulary; constant English language interference impedes comprehension.

Fluency

- 5 Steady, fluid speech
- 4.5 Very little hesitation
- 4 Occasional hesitance
- 3.5 Labored fluidity
- 3 Continual hesitance

Pronunciation

- 5 Excellent pronunciation
- 4.5 Very good pronunciation
- 4 Good pronunciation
- 3.5 Fair pronunciation, may affect comprehension
- 3 Poor pronunciation, impeding communication
