## Suggested Family Activities

### Money Moves

Are you looking for ways to help your child retain the lessons from *Biz Kid\$*? Try the following activities.

- Where does the money go once you spend it at a store? Take your child on a money journey to follow its flow in your town. Visit a local store, and ask the store's owner or manager to explain what happens to the money earned each day. The store owner likely will say that the money is sent to a financial institution for safekeeping. Travel to a financial institution to see where the money goes from there. Follow the path of the money as far as you can while staying in town. This will help provide your child with a firsthand understanding of financial flow.
- Save store circulars from different times of the year, and write the date on each advertisement. Share your collection with your child, and explore how prices change according to the time of year and the demand for those items. For example, summer clothes tend to go on sale as the summer season draws to an end.
