

Segment Seven: Ebb and Flow

Essential Question: What is the future of La Crosse based on past history, what will the city/region look like in the year 2065?

Grade 4 Activity: *La Crosse A to Z*

Directions: Create a *La Crosse A to Z* book using information from the program and other resources. Words should pertain to people, places, events, and the history of La Crosse. The students may want to illustrate this class book.

For example:

A is for Adolf Gundersen – the first medical director of Lutheran Hospital

B is for Black River – an important water highway for lumbering
