Activities in the past tense	Explain what happened in each room with two (2+) or more sentences using the imperfect tense for each room.	The past tense is someone used correctly. Conclusion	Have a specific conclusion to your story.	Your conclusion is difficult to follow.	Ensure that you include a very specific conclusion to your situation.	(x2)	(x2)
Photo Story Captions	Photo Story includes captions for each photo. Captions have been edited for spelling errors.	Photo Story includes captions on some photos. Captions include spelling errors.	Proofread captions for spelling and ensure that every photo has captions.	(x5)	(x5)
Speaking	Reads fluently from your script and pronounces words clearly.	Some mispronunciation of words and hesitation when reading the script.	Practice reading the script before recording. Ask about pronunciation if unsure.	(x5)	(x5)
Storyboard Script	Turns in a completed, error free script that follows the photo story.	A rough draft of your presentation includes errors or does not follow photo story.	Proofread more than once and make sure it follows your photo story.	(x3)	(x3)
